The combination of beer and whiskey is known as a 'boilermaker' in America, where blue-collar labourers regarded it as an effective pick-me-up after a shift down in the mines.

Ripe with cherries & dried fruit, while also delivering flavours of vanilla and charred oak

Basil Hayden - Straight Bourbon **J**...\$12

Enriched by a hint of peppermint, with notes of pepper balanced by slight citrus overtones

Basil Hayden - Toasted.....\$12

Consisting of dried fruit, toasted oak, and caramelized sugar aromas.

Rabbit Hole Cavehill **M** **J** .....\$12

Flavours of salted caramel, honey, orange, mint and grain.

—Did you know?—

To be classified as bourbon, a whiskey needs to be distilled from a mixture of grains, or mash, that's at least 51% corn. That corn gives bourbon its distinctive sweet flavour.

Mitcher's US1 Small Batch **M**.....\$16

Flavours of salted caramel, dried fruit & toasty oak with notes of butterscotch and orange

Mitcher's US1 Sour Mash **J**.....\$16

Burnt sugar, spice, tree fruit and vanilla notes up front, ginger & black pepper on the finish

—Did you know?—

The famous red-wax sealed Maker's Mark bottle was designed by the distillery owner's wife, Margie Samuels. Samuels wanted something that would stand out in the liquor store and reassure drinkers that this bourbon was quality made. She also came up with the name, which comes from the "mark of the maker," a signature that indicates a product is handmade.

Jim Beam - Straight Bourbon.....\$7

Mellow hints of caramel, vanilla, grain & oak flavour with a lightly sweet, toasted oak finish

Jack Daniels - Sour Mash.....\$7

Smooth and toasted with pronounced vanilla notes; silky and balanced

Frank Sinatra was buried with a bottle of Jack Daniel's.

Mitcher's US1 Single Barrel Rye **R** **D** \$18

Full of caramel, vanilla, & a slight floral touch followed by vanilla, caramel, coconut flavours

Flavours of corn, wood spice and caramel, with hints of dill and nut.

Maker's Mark **S**.....\$9

Smooth with delectable toffee and milk chocolate flavour with a lightly spiced finish

Expect to find the warming notes of brown sugar, toffee and spice

Skrewball - Peanut Butter.....\$9

An ultra-unique combination of whiskey and peanut butter with buttered popcorn flavours

## KENTUCKY OWL

Kentucky Owl Bourbon was founded in 1879. The distillery produced "The Wise Man's Bourbon" until prohibition became law in 1916. When federal agents seized 250,000 gallons of Kentucky Owl and shipped the barrels up river to the state capital. A short time after the warehouse mysteriously burned and the remains of the barrels were never found or seen again. 100 years later, the great great grandson revived the brand, and this story became the inspiration for Kentucky Owl Confiscated.

## Blood Oath

And three, a 7-year-old finished in Spanish Oloroso Sherry casks which carries the aroma of sweet sherry while satiating the palate with a melody of ripe fruits including figs, plums, and raisins, with notes of molasses and chocolate.

Barrels of Jefferson's Ocean Aged at Sea Bourbon travel aboard ships that visit ports all around the globe.
